Iping signs: WSCC has put up notices to inform the public that the signs will go up in Iping Lane south and Iping Lane north near Hammerwood.

Stedham Lane flooding: The Parish Council has applied for WSCC Watershed grants to stop the flooding near Meadowhills and at Bridgefoot Cottages.

Durand Academy: We are informed that a planning application for temporary classrooms at the St Cuthmans site is to be expected soon.
